Effects of the Bund-Länder-agreement regarding the Coronavirus: No sendings to closed retail stores in Germany.



The federal government in cooperation with the state governments took radical measures yesterday. The goal is to contain the coronavirus and to slow down the spread of the virus.

Shutdown of retail stores in Germany

The decision of the federal government leads to a shutdown of retail stores in Germany. In addition to that bars, clubs, discos, theatres, opera houses, concert halls, museums, fairs, movie theatres, amusement parks have to shut down. Sport facilities, gyms, indoor and outdoor pools and playgrounds are affected too.

Explicitly not closed will be retail stores for food! Pharmacies, drug stores, gas stations, banks, delivery stores, post offices will not be closed as well. There will be official requirement suchs as hygienic requirements and an access control to avoid long queues.

Providers and workshops are allowed to continue work. All institutions of healthcare remain open considering the increasing requirements in hygienics.

What are the consequences of this for the transport sector?

You as customer are responsible for the acceptance at the given loading and unloading points. Please check in advance if the receiver is open and able to receive the consignment.

We expect that all institutions, stores and business which have closed because of the decision of the federal government are not able to receive consignments. Please dont send no goods if the receiving store or business is affected by the decision and had to close.

Consignments, which can't be delievered by us because the receiving store or business is closed, will be send back to you without a separat order on the same day or the next day.. The resulting costs have to be borne by you as sender.

Additional delivery periods may occur

The wide european and national preventive measures may cause exceeding delivery periods, which we can't control. Regarding this background binding commitments for delivery periods can not be made by us. Delays in delivery caused by the coronavirus pandemic are classified as higher force. We would like to point out that all demands resulting of delays of delivery caused by the coronavirus pandemic have to be rejected by us because of actuarial reasons until further notice. The liability and insurance cover on the basis of our terms and conditions ADSp 2017 does not apply in this case. This also applies for transport contracts with an ensurance for transport.
